When a variable locator is followed by the same locator, the space between is generated by the program, it recognizes the paragraph leading which is usually the same as the top leading. DO NOT use

DO NOT use 4N function on a variable locator. Put the superior reference where it is indicated, put the AN after the first word in the next paragraph, and key the footnote at the end of the paragraph. To be absolutely safe, DO NOT use a AN on any head.

NEVER interrupt the AN function: Key the footnote immediately following the paragraph that contains the reference; not even AQ space can be keyed in between.

DO NOT use the AN function in leaderwork. DO NOT use the AN in a AP, subcolumn rou-

DO NOT end an extension with a head locator. Relative locator can only be used on full meas-

DO NOT use relative locator in the middle of a word.
